Laboratory Safety: Basic Fundamentals will provide an overview of laboratory safety requirements, including:

- Recognition and mitigation of laboratory hazards
- The use of engineering controls, administrative controls and personal protective equipment
- Working safety with specific and general chemicals
- Working with the MSDS
